COOKIES POLICY



1. Introduction

Camaroz Group LTD (**hereafter “the Company”**) is a company incorporated under the laws of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines that owns and operates the brand “**TraderXlab**” and the domain www.TraderXlab.com.

As it is common practice with the majority of professional websites, this website is using cookies to provide the user/visitor with a better experience on the website. This document explains what cookies are, how these are used, what information they gather and why sometimes we need to store these cookies.

This Cookies Policy applies to all of the Company’s website(s), branded pages on third party platforms and applications accessed or used through such websites or third-party platforms which are operated by or on behalf of the Company.

By using the Company’s website(s), you are consenting to the use of cookies in accordance with this Cookie Policy. If you do not agree with the use of cookies in this way, you should set your browser settings accordingly or not use the Company’s website. Please kindly note that if you disable the cookies we use, this may impact your user experience while on the Company’s website(s).

2. What are Cookies?

Cookies are small files or pieces of information, which usually include a unique identification number or value, and may be stored on your computer (or other internet enabled devices, such as a smartphone or tablet) when you visit the Company’s website(s) and trading software in order to enable the users to perform certain functions on the website(s).

3. How we use Cookies

Cookies are commonly used to optimize the functionality of the Company’s website(s) in order to provide the visitors with a more relevant and effective experience on the website, including presenting the Company’s products according to your personal preferences, interests and needs as well as to help speed up your future activities and experience on our website(s). Cookies may also be used to compile aggregated statistics that allow us to understand how visitors use our website(s) and to help us improve their structure and content. Please note that this statistics are anonymous and we cannot personally identify you.



Cookies are frequently used on many internet websites and you can choose if and how a cookie will be accepted by changing your preferences and options in your browser. Please note that some of our business partners (i.e. affiliates, introducing brokers, associates, advertisers) use cookies on our website(s) and we have no access to, or control over these cookies.

The cookies do not contain personally identifying information nor are they used to identify you. You may choose to disable these cookies however should you choose to do so, it may affect the accessibility and functionality of some parts of the website(s) and as a result you may be unable to access or use them.

4. What type of Cookies we use

There are two types of cookies used on the Company's website(s) – temporary and persistent. Temporary cookies remain on your computer or device only for the duration of the website's usage. Once you leave the Company's website(s) or close your browser these cookies are deleted. A persistent cookie remains on your computer or device for a longer period of time depending on the "lifetime" duration of the specific cookies and your browser settings or until you manually delete it.

The following types of cookies are used on the Company's website(s):

4.1. Session Cookies

Session cookies are used to enable the user to move around the Company's website(s) and use its features. It also used to retain the information the user provides us with as (s)he navigates through each section of our website(s) such as remembering previous actions (e.g. entered text).

These cookies do not identify you as an individual. Non-acceptance of these cookies may affect the performance of the website or parts of it.

4.2. Analytical Cookies

Analytical cookies provide us with anonymous/aggregated information regarding how you use the Company's website(s), for how long and what you do on both the Company's website(s) and other websites.

Analytical cookies do not divulge any identifying information specific to your person but they do help us improve how we provide you with our content.



4.3. Functional Cookies

These cookies allow our website(s) to remember and save the choices you make (such as your user name or your preferred language) to provide a more personalised online experience across our website(s).

The information these cookies collect may include personally identifiable information that you have disclosed, such as your username or profile picture. If you do not accept these cookies, it may affect the performance and functionality of the website and may restrict access to content on the website.

4.4. Performance

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with the Company's website(s) by providing information about the areas visited, the time spent on the website, and any issues encountered, such as error messages. This helps us improve the performance of our websites.

These cookies do not identify you as an individual. All information and data is collected and aggregated anonymously.

4.5. Advertising

These cookies are used to customize the website(s) content according to what is more relevant to your preferences and your interests. They may be used to deliver targeted advertising or to limit the number of times you see an advertisement. They also help us measure the effectiveness of advertising campaigns on the Company's websites.

We may use these cookies to remember websites you have visited and we may share this information with other parties, including advertisers and our agencies. These cookies may collect some personal identifiable information such as the user's IP address.

4.6. Third Party Cookies

When you visit the Company's website(s) you may receive cookies from third party websites or domains. The Company uses cookies provided by trusted third parties such as social media websites (i.e. Google+, Facebook, YouTube etc.) or its advertising partners (such as affiliates, business introducers etc.).



Third Party cookies help us to understand how you use the Company's website(s) and configure ways in which we can improve your experience as well as how you use social media buttons and/or plugins to connect with your social network. Social media website(s) may set cookies through our website(s) which may be used to enhance your profile on their site or contribute to the data they hold for various purposes outlined in their respective privacy policies.

You can disable the use of these cookies through your browser's privacy settings but please do note that this will also disable all the functions described above.

5. How to disable Cookies

You can change your browser settings to adjust, modify, prevent or block cookies; or to alert you when cookies are being sent to your computer or device (see your browser Help for how to do this). Please note however that by disabling cookies it will may have a negative impact on your browsing experience while on the Company's website(s) and any other websites that you visit. Disabling cookies will usually result in also disabling certain functionalities and features of the website(s) or you may be unable to visit or use certain areas of the Company's website(s). Therefore, it is recommended that you do not disable such cookies.
